## Jellyfish Advice



### What to do if stung?

- Soak or rinse the area in sea water;
- DO NOT use fresh water as this releases more toxins
- Apply alcohol to the area
- DO NOT rub the area
- DO NOT apply ice or hot water
- Remove tentacles with a stick, card, or a pair of tweezers
- Seek immediate medical aid if you have: difficulty breathing or swallowing, chest pain or intense pain in the area

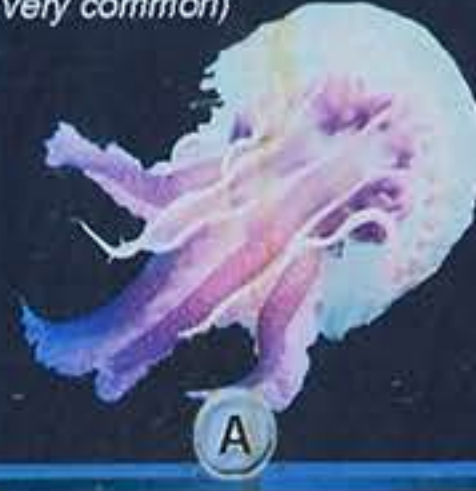

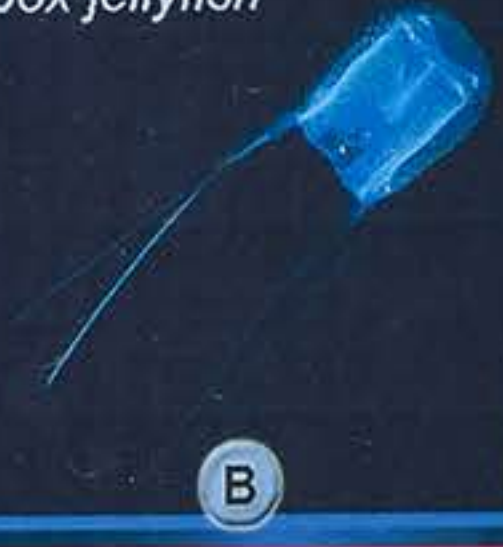
